SAT Scores

Fruitland High School's SAT scores were above the state average and were the highest of our local Idaho schools.

2

Singapore Math

K-6th grade students and staff completed their fourth year of the rigorous Singapore math curriculum.

FFA, BPA, HOSA

Our FFA chapter had *FOUR* state-winning teams that will represent Idaho at the National FFA Convention this fall. BPA had a national qualifier, as did HOSA.

All-Day Kindergarten

We completed our second year of all-day, tuition-free kindergarten for all students--in our newly opened Early Childhood Center.

High School Honor

US News/World Report named FHS the 18th best of 212 high schools in Idaho--all sizes and types--and the best high school in our metro area.

6

Elementary Reading

As part of the early literacy initiative, we have added a Reading Specialist/Coach position for next year.

HS Athletics

We had state champions in cross country, wrestling, track, tennis, and golf. Had our second 4-time wrestling state champion. We were *academic* state champions in four sports. MaxPreps named Fruitland the best high school sports town in Idaho.

Middle School +'s

Our middle school added baseball, Tech-No (focusing on activities without electronic devices and cell phones), Robotics Club, advanced art classes, and a new STEM elective. Students completed 86 online high school courses while still in middle school.

9

College Credits

High school students completed 876 dual college credits, plus 44 on TVCC's campus, and 9 through online courses. AP results are not in, but will result in more college credits.

Music!

Our high school marching band competed at the large 5A level (we are a 3A school). We hosted the Troopers for their pre-season camp. Our new musical theatre class presented two musicals.
