BUILDING WALK THROUGH
FEBRUARY 12, 2018**

The School Board toured the FSD buildings on February 12, 2018. Each building administration discussed areas of need with the Board:

TRANSPORTATION DEPARTMENT

The Board visited Sonny Adams, Assistant Transportation Supervisor. Mr. Adams talked to the Board about the following:

- Stop Arm Violations
- Consider hiring a bus aide next year
- Just hired one bus driver
- One trip driver short
- Purchase a small bus for activities
- Adding Rout 3 has helped bus load sizes

DISTRICT OFFICE / INTERVENTION ROOM

- Mrs. Fabricius took the Board to visit the District Office & Intervention Room.

PREP ACADEMY

The Board visited Gayle VanWeerdhuizen, Prep Academy Director. Mrs. VanWeerdhuizen talked to the Board about the following:

- Students are broken into math groups
- Students are sewing blankets for the MSTI
- School garden will start up this spring
- Summer School average 40-45 students
- IDLA average 18-20 students
- Graduation

FRUITLAND HIGH SCHOOL
